

Dunguaire Castle Banquet

Kinvarra Co Galway

- On arrival to the castle there is a short history of the Castle and a musical introduction by the Castle Singers
- Then guests climb the staircase to enter the Banquet Hall. There the bench seating, dim candle - light and long oak tables reflect the Banqueting style of the medieval era.
- The 4 course meal is a pleasant balance of Irish Fish and Meat dishes as served during the period and is accompanied with music, song and verse.
- After dinner, we invite you to sit back, relax and enjoy the entertainment programme, which takes the form of a selection of songs, poems and excerpts from the Irish Literary writers and poets that were associated with the Galway Region e.g. Yeats, Synge, Shaw, Gogarty and Fahy.
